I. CALL TO ORDER

- a. Natasha called the meeting to order at 12:03

II. REVIEW OF DECEMBER MINUTES

- a. Randy motioned to approve December minutes as presented. Linda seconded. All approved.

III. HEALTH NURSE REPORT

- a. Natasha – There is an increased number of Influenza A reports. There have also been several cases of RSV. There is currently a nationwide shortage for children’s Tylenol. The pharmacy is working with parents to help with correct dosing of regular Tylenol to get the children what they need during an illness.

IV. UNFISISHED BUSINESS

a. HOMESTEAD UPDATE

- i. Nancy – The complaint has been filed. There was a hearing date set, but Mr. Weitz asked for an extension. The extension was granted. New hearing date is January 19, 2023.

V. FLOOD PLAIN UPDATE

- a. Stephanie – The county continues to work with FEMA and State Des to extend grant resources to continue to assist with the review of flood plain applications. The county also seen some flooding last week due to ice jams.
